We cannot reiterate enough how important it is to us that students, faculty, staff, and the public are aware of the different resources available to you: whether it's in a mobile app, scooter registry, or other things found this newsletter, we have the tools to help prepare you in the face of danger.

The purpose of this newsletter is to highlight our work throughout the UVA Community by showcasing our employees, general safety messaging, and educating you on the resources at your fingertips. Please know most of all, that safety will always be our top priority. Okay, class dismissed.



## What's a UVA Alert?

Throughout the year, the University community may receive different types of alerts from our department.

These notices are to inform the community of a threat, or a potential threat, in the area. The severity of the threat is associated with the type of notification we may send: UVA Alert being the most serious and requiring you to take an immediate action, a Safety Advisory, which notifies you of certain past criminal activity, or our General Communications, such as road closures, incoming inclement weather, or other non-urgent safety information.

These notifications are part of the federal requirement outlined in the Jeanne Clery Campus Safety Act. You can read more about the differences between the different safety notifications at UVA in the chart below.

UVA issues three types of safety notices based on urgency







## CRIME HAS OCCURRED & POSES SERIOUS.

Safety Advisory

#### IMMINENT THREAT. MAY REQUIRE ACTION TO STAY SAFE

- · Issued upon confirmation by University first responders
- · Examples include:
  - · Tornado warning
  - · Gas leak
  - · Armed intruder
  - · Chemical/hazardous materials spill
  - Fire/explosion

## ONGOING COMMUNITY THREAT

- · Certain serious crimes which have occurred and which pose an ongoing threat to the community.
- · Issued as information is available and on a case-by-case basis for certain crimes which have occurred either on Grounds or in an area immediately bordering Grounds
- · Examples may include notices about sexual assault, robbery, or other crimes, with info that may enable community members to better protect themselves from similar incidents

### **General Communication**

#### **AWARENESS ABOUT SAFETY ISSUES**

- · Acknowledgement that a widely known threat or condition is being monitored
- · Modifications to operating schedule
- · Update to previous safety incident

# TIPS FROM THE CORNER

We know that students are on Grounds at all times of day, studying at the library with friends or enjoying nightlife on the Corner. Please keep your safety in mind. There are many resources if you are on the Grounds at night and need assistance. Options include utilizing an <a href="Emergency Blue Light Phone">Emergency Blue Light Phone</a>, the <a href="UVA Ready mobile Safety App">UVA Ready mobile Safety App</a>, and speaking with a <a href="UVA Ambassador">UVA Ambassador</a>!

Here are a few more tips:

- Let a friend know when you leave/arrive home.
- Utilize <u>Night Pilot, UTS On Demand</u>, Safe Walk, <u>Transloc</u>, or Charge-A-Ride to get home safely.
- If you see someone in distress, say something or report it via phone or text to UVA Police.






## UNIVERSITY POLICE GIVE BACK


## **UVA ALERTS**

We strongly encourage the public to enroll in <u>UVA Alerts</u> to ensure safety messaging reaches everyone in attendance. Text, "UVA" to 226787 to enroll in mobile alerts or download the <u>UVA Ready mobile safety</u> app. There is no charge for either service.

UVA has utilized different versions of a safety app over the past several years. However, we wanted to work with our partners in the community to create a fully branded, one-stop safety preparedness app that covers several topics, issues, and resources from all across Grounds.

In August 2024, UVA Ready was officially launched in the app stores. We are so proud to bring this app to everyone that utilizes Grounds. Safety will always be our top priority.

#### WHAT DOES IT EVEN DO?

UVA Ready offers several UVA resources to make sure that you are prepared in the event of an emergency. Use the app to call 911, send a tip to UVA Police, receive UVA Alerts, send an "I'm OK!" message and your location to loved ones during an emergency, and more!

#### **CAN PARENTS USE IT?**

Absolutely! UVA Ready is available to anyone with a smartphone, including parents and the public. Just download it and start. Students, faculty, and staff can log in with their UVA username and password to access even more resources within our community.

#### WHERE CAN I DOWNLOAD IT?

UVA Ready is available for free in the <u>Apple App Store</u> and the <u>Google Play Store</u>. They are entirely free and available to anyone. Just look for the logo!

### WILL THE APP TRACK ME?

No. The only people that can see your location are those you share it with directly, UVA Ready does not track your location on a regular basis.
